RESOLUTION 07-2006

**FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING A FAST TRACK ALTERNATIVE
TO THE PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED PROJECTS
WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF BOISE FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT NO. 10**

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2006, the Board of Directors of Boise River Flood Control District No. 10 (FCD#10) adopted resolution 02-2006 for the purpose of adopting procedures for review and approval of proposed projects within the jurisdiction of FCD#10 ("Resolution 02-2006");

WHEREAS, it has become apparent that certain proposed projects within the jurisdiction of FCD#10 do not necessitate the use of the review and approval process set forth in Resolution 02-2006;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following policy is hereby established by this Board of Directors as FCD#10 policy for fast track review and approval of certain qualifying projects:

- A. The requirements set forth in Resolution 02-2006 may be waived without the need for FCD#10 Board approval if the FCD#10 District Engineer and FCD#10 Project Manager concur in writing upon written request by an applicant that the proposed land use change: (1) will not cause a rise in the base flood elevation; (2) is on property that does not contain any river frontage; or (3) is on property that is less than five (5) acres;
- B. The District Engineer and the Project Manager shall have the option, in their sole discretion, to refrain, either mutually or independently, from executing a written request of an applicant to be excluded from the requirements of Resolution 02-2006, in which event the land use change application shall immediately become subject to the requirements of Resolution 02-2006;
- C. In the event the District Engineer and the Project Manager both sign off on the applicant's request for exclusion from the requirements of Resolution 02-2006, a copy of the fully executed document shall be sent to the Chairman of the Board of Directors of FCD#10 by the applicant via certified mail. The Chairman of the Board of Directors of FCD#10 shall have the ability in his or her sole discretion to object to the consent of the District Engineer and Project Manager which shall immediately terminate the effectiveness of the District Engineer and Project Manager's consent described herein above and shall subject the applicant to the requirements set forth in Resolution 02-2006. In the event the Chairman of the Board of Directors of FCD#10 does not communicate, by reasonable means, an

objection to the applicant within fourteen (14) days of the date that the certified consent document is placed in the mail with the U.S. postal service, the consent will be deemed to have been approved and shall immediately become effective.
