RESOLUTION 06-2006

**FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURE FOR
RESPONDING TO FLOODING EVENTS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Boise River Flood Control District No. 10 (FCD#10) has been repeatedly requested to respond to flooding events on private property that were caused by conditions created by persons or entities, as opposed to flooding events that arise solely as a result of uncontrollable acts of nature;


WHEREAS, FCD#10 has not been charged with the duty or responsibility of responding to flooding events such as those described herein above and that by agreeing to respond to such flooding events, FCD#10 may be exposing itself to unnecessary liability;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that FCD#10 will only respond to flooding events such as those described above under the following circumstances:

1. The private property owner or the private property owner's legal representative requests FCD#10's help and executes a contract agreeing to fully compensate FCD#10 for the services rendered; or
2. FCD#10 is requested to respond by another local, state, or federal governmental entity that is directly involved in an emergency response.


